Musical Director – Cynthia Ensign Baney

Mrs. Baney has earned many awards for educational excellence. She is a two time recipient of the coveted Lilly Endowment Teacher Creativity Fellowship, as well as the IPALCO Foundation Golden Apple for excellence in teaching. Baney's ongoing work with the Indiana Department of Education led to the creation of three musicals for which she was awarded the Olin Davis Award from the Indiana Council of Economic Education for her creative musicals written to teach economic principles. Baney is a music specialist for Carmel Clay Schools.

Musical Choreographer – Lindsey Ratner

Ms. Ratner attended Carmel High School and performed three years in both the Accents Women's Show Choir and Ambassadors Mixed Show Choir. Love for music led her to Ball State, where she participated in Chamber Choir and University Singers and graduated with a degree in music education. Ratner served four years in Warren Township as an elementary music teacher, directing numerous elementary musicals, including two township-wide musicals involving over two-hundred students. Presently, Ratner has been teaching two years in the Carmel Clay School District at Woodbrook Elementary, where she has directed and choreographed musicals and led 4th and 5th grade choir, recorder ensemble and percussion ensemble. Currently, Ratner is studying to earn a Master's Degree in Music Education from Anderson University.

Curriculum Enrichment Director – Julie Williams

Julie Williams has a rich background in theater, vocal music and dance as well as speech competition. Her best memory from high school speech class was actually having the voice of Bart Simpson (Nancy Cartwright) as a classmate and fellow competitor. Mrs. Williams is a graduate of Indiana University, where she danced with the I.U. Red Steppers. She has taught for Carmel Clay Schools since graduating from I.U. in 1980. Mrs. Williams currently teaches 5th grade at Carmel Elementary School.

Camp Director – Steve Baney

Steve is an Indiana University graduate and a long time educator in HSE schools, a math teacher at the junior high level since 1992. He also is a Lilly Endowment Teacher Creativity Fellowship recipient and participated in the Key Teachers Program through the Indiana Council of Economic Educators. Mr. Baney has also worked with youth through his involvement in coaching in youth recreation sports, junior high and high school athletics. Steve made his theatrical debut in Fishers Junior High's production of High School Musical.

Culture Collaboration – Kanji Camp

Kanji Camp Japanese Language & Culture Program will provide a seasoned instructor who has taught for KC, IBLCI and IUPUI's CLN.
